# Week 1: GOD'S BIG PICTURE OVERVIEW OF THE BIBLE

The book of Ephesians is one of the many great books found in the Bible! It is a letter from God, written by Paul to every person and church that follows Christ Jesus. While there are some things we may not understand until heaven, God decided to make some things very clear and available for us to grasp. As we grow and mature in our relationship with Christ, we grow in understanding God's plans.

### Conversation No. 1

#### THE BIG PICTURE

"Mom, are we there yet?" This familiar question inevitably occurs somewhere within the first 15 minutes of the 10-hour family road trip! Without understanding maps, directions, and travel time, children have no concept of the big picture. All they can see is the snippet of scenery that races by the car window. And, unless someone with understanding is at the wheel, that family will never reach their destination!

#### THE BIBLE IS A LOVE STORY

In the beginning, God created the entire world and it was good. God created people and delighted in them! Unlike any other created thing, God made people in His image (Genesis 1–2). Then, the unspeakable happened. Humanity rejected God and sin crashed into Creation like a tidal wave, leaving death and destruction in its wake (Genesis 3). In that moment, we became messed up! All people sin and fall short of God's glorious standard (Romans 3:23).

Despite our sin, God loves people and enacted a plan to save us. Through His chosen man, Abraham, God made a promise to bless all people. God created the nation of Israel as people chosen by God to be a light in the darkness and point others back to God (Genesis 12). However, the people of Israel had a hard time letting their light shine. Like those before them, they continued to fail and reject God.

In a pinnacle moment in mankind's history, God sent the Ultimate Solution to mankind's problem. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to earth in human form. Though innocent, Christ died a criminal's death on the cross to pay for our sins. Three days later, God raised Jesus from the dead! He is alive! Jesus is God's redemption plan and greatest act of love.

<sup>8</sup> But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. <sup>9</sup> And since we have been made right in God's sight by the blood of Christ, he will certainly save us from God's condemnation. <sup>10</sup> For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son. (Romans 5:8–10)

### Let's Hear from God

Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. (Romans 5:1) According to this verse, why can you and I have peace with God? Why do you believe our faith is important to God? Let's Hear from God *Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her.* (Ephesians 5:25b) "Who" is the Church? According to this verse, how does Christ feel about the Church and what has Christ done for her?

At Christ's command, the Church was born and carries on to this very day (Acts 2). It was during those early days after Christ returned to God the Father that the book of

Ephesians was written. And now, all of creation groans as we await the final chapter of God's story (Romans 8:22). We wait expectantly for the day when all things will be made new, restoration complete . . . the day when Jesus Christ returns to earth and the new Kingdom is revealed (Revelation 21)!



#### YOUR STORY IS PART OF GOD'S STORY

to live the dream rather than simply read about it. God offers this love to you. Until you embrace a tenderness and love for the Lord, the book of Ephesians will not have full impact on your life. In order to understand God's big picture, establishing a loving relationship with God through Jesus is the first step.

### Let's Hear from God
